### **Weebly Basics**

- Select a Theme
- Choose a Website Domain
- Enter Website Title
- Adding Elements
  - Add Title
  - Add Text
  - Add links (recommend opening to a new page)
  - Add images

### **Select a Design**

- Change Theme
- Change Font
- Select Background

### **Pages**

- Home Page (Title Page), page name, page layout
- Add a page (save and edit)
- Add another page (save and edit)

- Weebly for iPad
- **PROS:** Remarkably usable interface. Full set of templates and site elements.
- **CONS:** Lacks commerce features. Doesn't support blogging. No site traffic stats. Some stability issues. Can't modify site navigation.
- **BOTTOM LINE:** The Weebly iPad app breaks new ground in website building, but you probably still want to fire up your desktop browser for the job.
